- A five-question guiz that the class will take after your lesson (with answers). ٠
- A brief (2 paragraph) response (one for each partner) about your personal feelings toward the method. Would you use it? Did you learn a new technique that works for you? (This may be handwritten, but I WILL take points off if I can't read it!)

Information you need to include

- The teacher's major influences (Did they study with Stanislavski? Delsarte? Did they study opera, dance, language?)
- Their major style (presentational, representational, realism or theatricalism?) •
- A brief biography (about 2-5 minutes) including a photo. •
- A warm-up or activity that might be used by someone teaching their method or style (You must do the warm-up or activity with the class)
- Notable people who studied with them. ٠
- Projects that they worked on or took part in (Theatre companies, books they wrote, acting studios) •
- Training schools that still use their work today. •
- A complete bibliography of sources. •
