Class Information

ELA

Welcome back, Mustangs! We are kicking the school year off with a get to know you narrative project which will segway into our first unit of study - Rites of Passage. Unit 1 is focused on reading and writing narratives.

> Priority standards: RL2, W3, SL1, L1

Math

For August, we will be learning about the rules of exponents and how to simplify exponential expressions. We will also learn how to read, write, multiply and divide scientific notation. There will be a summative tentatively scheduled for August 30th or 31st.

Science

On Level HS Physical Science - This month we'll be learning about atoms, how they react with each other, and the Periodic Table! Our first test is tentatively scheduled for Aug. 25th/26th.

Social Studies

For the first few weeks, students will be learning about Georgia's geography, particularly the 5 regions. After that, students will learn the importance of Georgia's waterways and how that impacts the world economy. The impact of Georgia's

transportation systems on the state will also be examined.

Spanish

Spanish 1 - Unit 1 will focus on communication in a variety of formats: 1) Phonetic sounds in Spanish. Using simple Spanish phrases 2) to get to know one another. [greetings, farewells, and expressions of courtesy]. 3) Express likes & dislikes related to school topics and classes. 4) State feelings and ask others how they feel.

<u>Native Speakers</u> - <u>Unit 1</u> will focus on Identity. Students will dive into their country of origin, family, and language. Describe the Caribbean regions and express their signs of identity.
