However, on page 7 in section 2.0 Contract Details, it stipulates that FCS will only accept bids for the makes and models listed on the bid form below. No Other alternatives will be accepted at this time.</p> <p>These seem to be conflicting statements. Are you accepting substitutes to the HON specified items for this bid?</p>	<p>Thank you for your interest in Forsyth County Schools. Our Special Terms &amp; Conditions supersede our General Terms. The items listed are the only makes and models being considered.</p>
Worksmart Office Supply & Furniture	<p>Is it possible that all three buildings could require separate deliveries due to completion of construction? Ideally, we would like to do all three schools the same day/s, but if this is not a possibility, we will bid making three separate shipments/deliveries.</p>	<p>Each school should be treated a separate job for competition on separate days.</p>
Worksmart Office Supply & Furniture	<p>Did the school district choose the Hon products to specify for the bid or did a dealer present Hon as the products to specify for the project? The reason I ask is it makes a difference as to what price we get from Hon whether a dealer worked with the district to specify the Hon product or the district selected Hon on their own.</p>	<p>We selected the items specified as this has been our standard bookcase and file for the past several years.</p>
OI Atlanta	<p>Are there any stairs involved with any of the locations whether to gain access into the building or once inside the building to the individual install locations? If there are multiple floors are all accessible by elevator?</p>	<p>All locations have multiple floors accessible by elevator.</p>
OI Atlanta	<p>There are several references to a section called "Special Terms and conditions". I don't see this section. Is there one that was not included?</p>	<p>The special terms and conditions of the bid document begin on page 7.</p>
