

## Think-Tac-Toe Culminating Activity *Bad Boy*

Directions: **Choose 3 activities** to complete, in tic-tac-toe order which means diagonally, horizontally, or vertically; you may NOT skip around.

<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Brochure</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make a brochure advertising at least 3 of the colleges Walter mentions in the novel that many blacks attended back then</li> <li>• Cite at least 6 credible resources you used to research the colleges (2 articles per college; use Galileo and the password is rapids)</li> <li>• Include relevant information such as location of the college, tuition fees, the college's background and /or historical significance, etc.</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Song, rap or poem</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Write an original song, rap OR poem that accurately summarizes the memoir, Bad Boy, from the beginning to the end.</li> <li>• Your song, rap or poem MUST be typed</li> <li>• Any style is acceptable but it must be 12pt font</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Recreate the memoir "Bad Boy"</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Create a picture book of Walter Dean Myer's memoir, Bad Boy, for students in elementary school</li> <li>• Your version should include illustrations</li> <li>• Be sure to highlight the main events from the memoir not the entire story, so younger kids can read and understand the memoir and specific themes</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Diorama</i></b></p> <p>Use a shoe box to create ONE scene that is important in the novel. A typed summary must be attached to your diorama explaining the scene and it's importance You will be graded on your attention to detail. Make sure someone can understand what you have created and why it is important to the memoir. (You may need to label characters.)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>MUST DO! Research---Expository Essay</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Choose 1 topic addressed in the memoir: drug abuse, foster care, adoption, bullying, anger management, grief, depression, peer pressure, literacy, alchoholism, child abuse, or gang violence.</li> <li>• Locate, print and annotate 2 articles about the topic</li> <li>• Type a 4-paragraph expository essay, citing evidence from your articles, which does the following: 1)Explains the issue 2) Discusses how Walter Dean whether it is a prevalent issue today 4) Shares some</li> <li>• Include a Work Cited page</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Compare and Contrast</i></b></p> <p>Type a 1 ½ page essay comparing and contrasting Walter Dean Myers in Bad Boy to Squeaky in Raymond's Run or Alfonso in Broken Chain Double-space, Times New Roman, 12 pt font Your essay should explore a specific theme and how the characters responded to conflict.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Make Your Case</i></b></p> <p><u>Download the template</u> to make a CD case for a CD that summarizes the story <i>Bad Boy</i>. Choose a song that represents EACH chapter of Bad Boy (total of 20 songs)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Art</i></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Illustrate a comic strip describing the memoir, Bad Boy (your comic strip should include MAIN EVENTS form the memoir)</li> <li>• Your comic strip should have at least 10 frames</li> </ul>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b><i>Create a Book Cover</i></b></p> <p>Create a book cover, that captures one of the themes of the memoir and include the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A critic's review of the novel.</li> <li>• An illustration in color that represents the theme.</li> </ul>
