AP Scholar

A Bartram Trail AP Scholar (APS) student follows a rigorous program of study designed to meet the needs of the most highly motivated students. Students following the APS progression will be taking the most rigorous in each subject area, including Honors and Advanced Placement level courses. Students who enter and successfully complete the APS program will have a transcript that is competitive for the college admissions process and the Bright Futures Scholarship program. Additionally, APS students have the opportunity to earn college credit in a variety of subject areas. Applications are not necessary to be a part of the program but school counselors are available to help advise students who are pursuing this track.

APS students also have the opportunity to earn recognition from Bartram Trail High School, in conjunction with the College Board, as an AP Scholar, AP Scholar with Honor, AP Scholar with Distinction or a National AP Scholar. Please see the requirements below:

AP Scholar	Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams
AP Scholar w/Honors	Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams
AP Scholar w/Distinction	Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams
National AP Scholar	Granted to students in the United States who receive an average score of at least 4 on all AP Exams taken, and scores of 4 or higher on eight or more of these exams

AP INTERNATIONAL DIPLOMA

Some APS students might also qualify for an Advanced Placement International Diploma (APID), a diploma issued by the College Board, upon graduating from Bartram Trail HS. The APID is not a substitute for a high school diploma, but it provides additional certification of outstanding academic excellence. Our faculty has the experience and the training to implement College Board's AP courses and this curriculum challenges students to display exceptional achievement on AP Exams across several disciplines.
