2018-2019 BES Goals

<u>Reading</u>: In fifth grade, BES will increase the percentage of students scoring in "Proficient" or "Advanced" on the Scholastic Reading Inventory (SRI) from 59% in Spring 2018 to 61% in Spring 2019.



The end of year reading target scores are :

<u>130+ words per minute</u> and

Lexile comprehension score (SRI) of <u>920+</u>.

<u>Math:</u> In fifth grade, BES will increase the number of students scoring "Proficient" and "Advanced" on STAR Math from 54% in Spring 2018 to 56% in Spring 2019.



The end of year math target is 810+ on the STAR Assessment.

<u>Math</u> Increase Computation & Accuracy with Word Problems

- Provide parents resources & strategies to increase math computation & accuracy with word problems.
- Provide study guides for students and parents.

- Practice math fact flash cards each night with my child.
- Use resources & strategies found in notes & newsletters to help my child improve math computation & problem solving.
- Review word problems on study guides provided by teacher.

As a student, I will...

- Review math facts using my flash cards each night.
- Use math resources & strategies to solve math computation & word problems at home.
- Use study guides to review for tests.
