Blending Sounds to Make Words

As a school, we will...

- Send home upper and lower case alphabet flashcards.
- Provide parents with strategies, books, games, etc. to use at home to improve letter recognition and letter sound knowledge.
- Provide parents with strategies to help improve their child's ability to blend sounds and make words.

As a parent, I will...

- Practice alphabet flashcards nightly with my child until mastery of letters and sounds.
- Use strategies, books, games, etc. sent home with my child to help reinforce alphabet knowledge.
- Use provided strategies and resources to reinforce blending letter sounds to make words.

As a student, I will...

- Practice with my letter flashcards each night.
- Practice letter recognition and letter sounds with my parent using strategies, books, games, etc. provided by my teacher.
- Use strategies and resources to practice letter sounds and blending those sounds to make words.



By the end of year, your child should be able to correctly:

- compare 25 number sets in one minute and
- fluently add and subtract _____ problems in one

2019-2020 District Goals

The Pierce County School System will

- increase the percentage of students scoring at the Developing level or above in English Language Arts on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade (EOG) Assessment.
- increase the percentage of students scoring at the Developing level or above in Math on the Georgia Milestones End of Grade (EOG) Assessment.

2019-2020 BES Goals

Reading: In kindergarten, BES will increase the percentage of students scoring in DIBELS "Core Support" from 56% in Spring 2019 to 61% in Spring 2020.



By the end of year, your child should be able to correctly:

- Produce 40 letter sounds in one minute and
- blend 28 simple three letter (CVC) words in one minute.

Math: In kindergarten, BES will increase the percentage of students scoring in the "Average" and "Above Average" ranges on AIMSweb from 54% in Spring 2019 to 59% in Spring 2020.



By the end of year, your child should be able to correctly:

- Compare 25 number sets
- Fluently add and subtract 20 problems

- Provide materials to be used at home for counting practice & comparing sets/numbers.
- Provide parents with strategies/materials to help their child with simple addition and subtraction at home.
- Send home notes and newsletters with strategies for reviewing set comparisons and adding/subtracting numbers between 0 and 5.

As a parent, I will...

- Use the materials provided to practice counting & comparing objects with my child.
- Use provided strategies/materials to help my child with addition and subtraction.
- Help my child practice set comparisons and adding/subtracting numbers between 0 and 5 using the notes & newsletters provided by my child's teacher.

As a student, I will...

- Practice counting & comparing objects at home with my parent.
- Practice addition and subtraction with my parent.
- Bring home notes and newsletters from my teacher and practice set comparisons and adding/subtracting numbers between 0 and 5 with my parent.
