Marie Maynard Daly


First African-American woman to earn a Ph.D. in chemistry (1947)

An inner safety door kept mail safe from thieves and bad weather.




Sarah Goode First African American to receive a US Patent

Goode invented a desk that became a bed to save space.









His invention allowed the transportation of perishable foods such as produce and meats.




Ultraviolet Camera Spectrograph
