# **BPL Core Questions to Ask Principals**

## **Questions to ask EVERY month:**

- 1. Which students have a consistent problem with absenteeism or tardiness?
- 2. How many students have an LTI they enjoy and are invested in? This might involve:
  - They are on time to their LTI each day
  - They are up to date on their LTI and project work
  - They are enthusiastic about the LTI in 1:1 meetings, exhibitions, etc.
- 3. How many students have an LTI project that benefits the mentor and/or the organization (meaning...it's a real project)?
- 4. What are some of the 9th grade LTI projects? 10th grade? 11th grade?
- 5. What structures do you have in place to support your 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisor(s)?
- 6. On average, how many adults are working with students regularly in each advisory (staff member, mentor, specialists, volunteer, etc.)?
- 7. How are specialists spending time in advisories this month?
- 8. Are you regularly reviewing your whole school goals/expectations when you meet with your specialists? Advisors?
- 9. How many students have a book they are currently reading and enjoy? This might involve:
  - 1 book for interest
  - 1 book related to their internship
  - 1 book for book group
- 10. What progress are you making on your School Learning Plan goals?
- 11. What data are you using to measure this progress?
- 12. Are there any staff in crisis?
- 13. Are there any students in crisis?
- 14. What great advisory activities have been run this month in your school?
- 15. What would a visitor think of your building if they walked in? Is it neat? Are your campus goals apparent? Are samples of student work displayed?

## Specific questions to ask each month:

#### September:

- What diversity awareness activities do you have planned?
- What trips are advisories taking?
- Have you scheduled observation time in advisories? Do you have an evaluation form for your observation times?
- How are the 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisors doing? How is the culture in their advisory? What are you doing to help your 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisors get out to LTI sites?
- Have all students created their learning plans?
- Have you worked with each staff member to create their learning plans?
- Has everyone gotten the FERPA signed? Has everyone gotten their lunch forms and health forms in?
- How are the Who Am I projects developing?
- What are 10<sup>th</sup> graders working on for the first quarter?
- How many students are taking college classes?
- What are 11<sup>th</sup> graders working on for the first quarter?
- Do the 12<sup>th</sup> grade advisories have college visits scheduled?
- Do 12<sup>th</sup> graders know what colleges they are applying to?
- Have 12<sup>th</sup> graders started their college essays?
- How are 12th graders' STP proposals progressing?
- Remember: Scantron and Medicaid
- How have the 11<sup>th</sup> grade advisories planned to practice for the state assessment test (testing will be November 11-14, and again in March, 2007)

#### October:

- How are the 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisors doing? How is the culture in their advisory?
- Are there any students who haven't created a learning plan yet?
- Where are 9<sup>th</sup> graders with the Who Am I projects? What are some strong Who Am I projects you have seen?
- What are 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisors doing to prep their students for exhibitions?
- Have 10<sup>th</sup> grade advisories held a Parent Gateway night?
- What are 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students working on?
- What are 11<sup>th</sup> grade advisories doing for test prep?
- Have 12<sup>th</sup> graders finalized the list of colleges they are applying to?
- Have 12<sup>th</sup> graders gotten in all of their recommendation letters?
- How finalized are 12<sup>th</sup> graders' college essays?
- Have 12<sup>th</sup> graders started to schedule college interviews?

### November:

- How successful were the 9th grade exhibitions?
- How many students had parents at exhibitions?
- How many advisors have all their narratives done?
- How many students have created 2nd quarter LPs?
- What are 9th grade advisors doing to get kids out to LTIs?
- What else are 9th grade advisors having students work on this quarter?
- What are 10th grade advisories doing to prepare for Gateway?
- What else are 10th and 11th grade advisories having their students work on this quarter?
- How are students doing in their college classes?
- Are the 12th graders ready to send out their college applications?
- Have the 12th graders all completed a college portfolio and schedule interviews?
- Are the 12th graders finalizing their STP timelines?
- Have you reviewed the calendar with staff (second quarter is very short due to holidays)?
- Is there evidence in your building of your campus goals?

#### **December:**

- How are students/staff coping with the holiday season?
- What holiday celebrations/outings do you have planned for staff
- What are staff doing for students?
- What are 9th grade advisors doing to get kids out to LTIs?
- Where are 10th grade advisories in the Gateway planning process?
- How many students passed their college class?
- What are 11th grade advisories doing for test prep?
- Did all the 12th graders send out their applications?
- Did all 12th graders give a mini-college exhibition?
- What are 12th grade advisors doing to gear their students up for the STPs?

## January:

- SALT surveys how are you making sure all of your parents get this done?
- Are advisors doing a mid-year skills/experiences check-in with their students?
- How many parents were at exhibitions?
- How many exhibitions were held at internship sites?
- What are 9<sup>th</sup> grade advisors doing to get kids out to LTIs?
- What are the Gateway exhibitions looking like? What are advisors emphasizing with their students?
- Do 10<sup>th</sup> graders all have clear Gateway contracts? Are any students in real danger of not passing 10<sup>th</sup> grade?
- Which students are taking college classes?
- What are 11<sup>th</sup> grade advisories doing for test prep?
- How are the STPs progressing?
- Which students are being GRABbed? Are any in real danger of not graduating?
- How are 12<sup>th</sup> grade students doing with their autobiography?
- What are 12<sup>th</sup> grade advisors doing to help students identify scholarships?

## February:

- How many students have created 3rd quarter Learning Plans?
- What are 9th grade advisors having students work on this quarter?
- How are 10th grade students doing following up on their Gateway contracts?
- When are 11th grade advisors having their students brainstorm possible STPs? Write 1st drafts of college essays?
- What are 11th grade advisories doing for test prep?
- Do any 11th graders have reasons that might keep them from taking the state assessments?
- How are the STPs progressing?
- How many scholarships have 12th graders applied for?
- How many 12th grade parents were at the Money for College night?

### March:

- How are exhibitions being structured this quarter in each grade level?
- How are 11th grade students doing on the state assessments?
- How many 11th grade students have written brainstorms of possible STPs?
- How many 11th grade students have written first drafts of college essays?
- How many scholarships have 12th graders applied for?
- Have 12th grade advisors been working with students who aren't planning on going to college to identify other post-graduation options?
- Are any 12th graders seriously behind in their STPs?
- Are any 12th graders in danger of not graduating?

#### April:

- How many parents were at exhibitions?
- How many exhibitions were held at internship sites?
- How many students have created 4th quarter Learning Plans?
- What are advisories doing to find summer opportunities?
- How are 10th grade students doing meeting their Gateway contracts?
- How are students doing in their college classes?
- How many 11th grade students have completed drafts of their STP proposals? Of their college essays?
- Do 11th grade advisors have STP presentation panels planned?
- What are 11th grade advisors doing to help their students identify colleges they might apply to in the fall?
- How many scholarships have 12th graders applied for?
- Have 12th grade advisors been working with students who aren't planning on going to college to identify other post-graduation options?
- Have 12th graders completed all their financial aid paperwork?
- How many 12th graders are near completion of their STPs? How many are far behind?
- How many 12th graders are near completion of their autobiography? How many are far behind?
- Which 12<sup>th</sup> graders are being GRABbed? Are any in real danger of not graduating?

## May:

- Do all advisors have LTI exit meetings scheduled?
- What are advisors doing to help their students find LTIs for the fall?
- How many students have summer opportunities in place?
- How many advisories have spring trips scheduled?
- Are all 10th graders on track to pass Gateway? How are the 2nd Gateway exhibitions being structured?
- How are the 11th grade STP presentations going?
- How many 11th graders have found LTIs for the fall?
- Have 12th graders completed their STPs? Autobiographies?
- How many scholarships have 12th graders applied for?
- Do all 12th graders have a concrete plan for what they're going to do after graduation?
- Have 12th graders written their valedictorian speeches?

#### June:

- Are advisors doing an end-of-year skills/experiences check-in with their students?
- How are the final exhibitions being structured?
- Have all advisors had LTI exit meetings?
- Do all students have concrete summer plans in place?
- How many 10th graders passed their Gateway exhibition?
- How many 10th graders have LTIs lined up for the fall?
- How many 11th graders have LTIs lined up for the fall?
- How many 11th grade students have a tentative list of which colleges they will apply to in the fall?
- Do all 12th graders have a finalized post-graduation plan?
- Are 12th grade advisories all set for graduation?
