Middle school students are required to successfully complete three years of language arts, mathematics, science and social studies. Students who do not receive passing grades in their four core content classes (Math, ELA, Science and Social Studies) will be placed in course recovery.

Acceleration & Supports

Students may receive intensive reading or math support in a co-teaching setting based on student FSA (Florida Standards Assessment) scores.

Physical Education

All students are required to take 1 Semester of PE every year. If choosing an elective other than PE, a PE waiver must be completed by the parent on the back of this form. Completing a PE waiver does not guarantee that your student will not have PE.

Classes are offered based on the choices you make. The choices you make are binding. If you do not choose elective courses and your first-choice electives are full, your classes will be chosen for you and schedule change requests will not be honored. PE COURSE REQUIREMENT/WAIVER

Senate Bill 610 requires the equivalent of one class period per day of Physical Education for one semester each year for students in grades 6-8.

- Parent verifies that student participates in equivalent activities outside the school day
