- **Timeline:** The mid-year senior transcripts was shipped late January. You should check your BF account in March for your eligibility info. The last shipment of senior final transcripts will be submitted <u>by the district</u> in June.
- **Final Evaluations:** If you haven't submitted your volunteering hours & essay before January, your Bright Futures status in March will be continually shown as "ineligible" until the final uploading is completed and processed. All students with a completed application and final (after graduation) transcript submitted will receive award status notification posted to their online accounts in August.
- How do I check if my volunteering hrs. are recorded on my transcript? In your student skyward, click on Student Info and you will see the recorded hours right beneath your birthday and above emergency contacts.
- Check if you order your Bright Futures eligible SAT or ACT scores to be sent to <u>any State Universities</u> <u>in Florida</u> if you still see "missing test score" in your account during March.
