### MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** **2017 Operational Memo #13**  
**SY 16-17 Area Eligibility Percentages for CACFP**

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USDA Regulations mandate that At Risk Programs and Day Care Homes (for tiering) in CACFP use free and reduced price meal data from schools for determining area eligibility. Per 7 CFR §226.2 Definitions:

*Eligible area means:*

- (a) For the purpose of determining the eligibility of at-risk afterschool care centers, the attendance area of a school in which at least 50 percent of the enrolled children are certified eligible for free or reduced-price school meals; or
- (b) For the purpose of determining the tiering status of day care homes, the attendance area of a school in which at least 50 percent of the enrolled children are certified eligible for free or reduced-price meals, or the area based on the most recent census data in which at least 50 percent of the children residing in the area are members of households that meet the income standards for free or reduced-price meals.

Please see the attached list of free and reduced price percentages by school. The document contains free and reduced price percentages for some schools and then free claiming percentages for the schools operating under the Community Eligibility Provision (CEP).

This document should be used for determining eligibility for At Risk Programs and Family Day Care Homes tiering. This document reflects Delaware School Nutrition Program statistics as of October 2016.
