DATES/TIMES TO REMEMBER:

Rehearsal: To be announced - It is recommended that the girls practice in the shoes they plan to wear in the pageant.

Rehearsal is mandatory for all contestants and escorts, and as soon as a date and time is confirmed, the

applicants will be notified.

Pageant: Saturday, January 12, 2008

Please report to the Performing Arts Center no later than 6:00 PM to check in and receive your entry number. You will be directed backstage where you will line up in numerical order.

Contestants will go out to the stage first as a group(s) and then individually. The pageant begins at

7:00 PM.

Appropriate Attire: Although this event is considered a pageant, there is no need to spend an extravagant amount of

money on a dress, getting hair done, artificial nails, etc. While these things are allowed, they are not required. Bare mid-drift dresses are **not** allowed and all dresses must come to the bra line in the

back.

Pictures: Photographs will be offered prior to the pageant with reduced package prices for contestants.

Videotaping and photography is permitted during the pageant.

Calendars: Calendars will be sold prior to the pageant in the lobby. A group picture of all contestants will be

featured in the calendar. The calendar will also have large photos of the monthly winners and there

will be random shots of all the contestants from the pageant.

Flowers: Flowers will be on sight for purchase for contestants.

Awards: There will be a total of 14 winning contestants to represent the Ola High School Calendar Girl

Pageant for the year 2008. This includes a cover girl and a girl for each month. There will also be
