

1497	John Cabot	Discovers Newfoundland	
1534	Jacques Cartier	First to explore the St. Lawrence River & lays claim to surrounding land for France; called the land "New France"	
1608	Samuel de Champlain	Establishes 1 st permanent French settlement in Canada— Quebec	
1754	French and Indian War	Great Britain fought France for control of Canadian land & the fur trade	
1754	Great Britain	takes control of Quebec	
1763	Treaty of Paris	Gave Britain control of all lands east of the Mississippi River, except for 2 islands	
1774	Quebec Act	Guarantees the French the right to maintain their culture (language, religion, & traditions)	
1812	War of 1812	France and Great Britain work together against the US (who tried to invade Canada)	
1841	Upper & Lower Canada were united	Establishes the Province of Canada	
1867	British North America Act	Creates a federation union of Canada; 4 provinces were joined by 1 constitution	
1886	Transcontinental Railroad	Increased travel from Canada's east to west coast; created new provinces & territories; increased the shipment of goods across the country	
1898	Yukon Territory	was established to meet the needs of the growing population from the gold rush	
1905	Saskatchewan & Alberta	Provinces were created so that the government could collect taxes to pay for growing population	
1949	Newfoundland	Province joined Canada in order to have help building roads & railways	
1999	Nunavut	Territory was created so that the Inuit could have their own land & government
