| <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mandatory 14-day quarantine for any staff member or student with a confirmed case, living with/exposed to someone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19.</li><li>• Mandatory 14-day quarantine for all staff that have traveled to/from or who have someone living with them who has traveled to/from CDC designated Level 3 countries<sup>7</sup></li><li>• Mandatory 14-day quarantine for all students that have traveled to/from or who have someone living with them who has traveled to/from CDC designated Level 3 countries.<sup>7</sup></li></ul> | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Will consider confirmed cases in bordering states (PA, MD and NJ). All Decisions will be made at the District Level.</li><li>2. Transition between phases done in full consultation with state and local agencies</li><li>3. CSD will monitor COVID-19 status daily to determine appropriate phase</li><li>4. Focus of infection is defined as a geographical area with at least one confirmed case</li><li>5. Outside groups include all non-Capital School District sponsored organizations</li><li>6. Buildings closed to all students and staff - status will be reviewed and monitored daily; guidance will be sought from CDC and DE Division of Public Health</li><li>7. As per guidance from CDC and DE Division of Public Health; Level 3 countries include:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• China</li><li>• S.Korea</li><li>• Italy</li><li>• Iran</li><li>• Japan (Level 2)</li></ul></li></ol> |
