2021-2022 Data

- All students in grades K-5 participate in English and Language Arts (ELA) and Math iReady progress monitoring. **69%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in ELA and **73%** of K-5 students were on or above grade level in Math.
- The Star Early Literacy Assessment is administered to kindergarten students at the beginning of each school year. **49%** of students demonstrated kindergarten readiness compared to the state average of 57%.
