May 31 - June 3 | Famous Artists (4 Day Camp) / \$72

From Norman Rockwell to Jackson Pollock campers will learn distinct differences in the works of artists. Campers will create works of art based on the style of these two artists and more.

June 6 - 10 | Ready, Set, Draw

Campers will learn the foundations of art. They will build their drawing skills using a variety of mediums including color pencils, markers, charcoal, pastels, oil pastels and pencil. Campers will be introduced to works of art by famous artists using these mediums.

June 13 – 17 | Glass Art

Campers will learn how a stained glass piece is created. This fabulous historical art will be explored through a variety of techniques. Campers will select two small pieces of glass, grind and foil them. One piece of glass will become a part of a class abstract stained glass piece. The other piece will be turned into a pendant for the camper to keep. Campers will also meet stained glass artist Cindy Hammond whose works will be on exhibit in the Vereen Gallery.

June 27 - July 1 | Paint, Paint, Paint, Paint, Paint

Campers will spend their time exploring acrylic painting, watercolor painting, tempera painting and more. Each day will introduce a new medium! Campers will learn techniques used in paintings that are part of the Arts Center's Permanent Collection.

June 20 -24 | Dimensional Art

Campers will explore three dimensional arts through papier-mâché. Papiermâché is a composite material consisting of paper pieces or pulp, sometimes reinforced with textiles, bound with an adhesive, such as glue, starch, or wallpaper paste. Each work of art will be unique to the camper.

July 11 - 15 | Designs and Patterns

They are everywhere! Before your tennis shoes could be made-they had to be designed by someone! Design is a fundamental part of the art process. Campers will learn the process of design and discover how patterns are made in works of art as they enjoy the Arts Center Quilt Exhibit.

July 18 -22 | Folk Art

Everywhere you look – you will find art. Campers will explore art through weaving, printmaking and more. Campers will explore works of art in the Arts Center's Permanent Collection to learn how nature is expressed in art.

July 25 - 29 | Be the Architect

Campers will learn the art of drawing perspective and interior and exterior architecture. Campers will design their dream home and a medieval castle while learning the history of architect Frank Lloyd Wright.


