CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS IMMUNIZATION NOTICE

Georgia Law requires all public school students to have an up-to-date Georgia Immunization Form 3231 unless the student has an exemption (medical or religious). Vaccination requirements are as follows:

- haemophilus influenzae type b
- hepatitis A
- hepatitis B
- MMR (measles, mumps, rubella)
- MCV4 (meningitis)
- pneumococcal
- poliomyelitis
- DTap (diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis)
- varicella (chickenpox)

All students entering 7th grade must have Tdap and MCV4

Effective for the 2022-2023 School Year, all students entering or transferring into the 11th grade will need proof of a meningococcal booster shot (MCV4), unless their first dose was received on or after their 16th birthday.

Contact your Primary Care Physician, Clayton County Board of Health (678-470-7700) or the School Based Health Center at North Clayton High School (678-456-2800) for an appointment to meet the Georgia Public School requirement before school starts on August 1, 2022.
