All the options above are available to your student. Please be aware of the CCSD's new Course Extension Program which will be offered at Cherokee High School. The Course Extension Program is a 10-day opportunity for students who have a final course grade between 65-69 in the following courses:

- Students must prepay a \$40.00 fee to participate.
- Students will complete an online, individualized mastery pathway centered on content/standards.
- All graded components of this pathway must score at an 80%.
- Upon successful completion of the mastery pathway within the 10-day window, the student will receive a final course grade of a 70.
