

If an individual wants to "act a fool" they will be separated from the group and have to complete an assignment on their own












Individuals

This individual was a slave that fought at the Battle of Kettle Creek. He was given land later as a reward for his services.






Austin Dabney






King George III

This is the term for the group of rebels that fought for their independence.




Patriots



Woodland




This Document was created by Thomas Jefferson. It suggests that the colonists should form their own nation free from British rule.








Blue Ridge Mountains









What Geographi c Region is labeled below?

Valley and Ridge






















