# The Certification Program is designed to:

- Assure the public

#### Certification is based on:

- Individual mastery of FCS knowledge as verified by a bachelor's degree
- Successful completion of the National FCS Exam

# Certification eligibility:

- Pass the exam
- Subscribe to the AAFCS Code of Ethics
- Provide a college transcript
- Submit the CFCS application and fee

- Complete the application form (online)
- Receive authorization form from AAFCS
- Make appointment to take exam at SMT center
- Take exam and pay fee (\$150)
- Special exam administrations
