This extension allows users to open a sticky note on top of any website and it saves as a bookmark for readers to record and return to an article at any time and continue from where they left off. Or, they can simply record a quick word for reference to study again later. Notes can be made in any position on the screen and are saved in real time synchronizing to your account. They automatically load the notes as the user reuses common websites recording note counts each time a new note is written.

## Speak it

When the majority of readers come across a new word and are uncertain as to its pronunciation or meaning, they may subconsciously ignore the word, giving it no value in the sentence! This new tool called Speak it allows them to select a word or group of text to read and the extensions will read the highlighted text allowing the user to hear the proper pronunciation! This tool can be used for various languages, simplifying the process of learning a new tongue!

## Announcify

If you want to listen to a web page for whatever reason, no matter if it's due to lack of focus or tired eyes, you can use announcify, which will read every website out loud and help you understand what you're reading.
