All year	Pass all classes! Students must pass all their current classes <u>and</u> retake any courses they did not pass last year.	* 92.5 overall GPA required to graduate as an Honor Graduate. * Academic GPA affects HOPE eligibility. 23 credits required to graduate!
All year	Continue to maintain good attendance! More than 7 absences will require an appeal.	Mrs. Ramey, Attendance Clerk
All year	Senior Capstone Project All seniors will complete a senior project.	This will be completed during Capstone Days throughout the year.
Fall	Sr. Meeting: Finalize plans for after H.S. The Senior Counselor will meet with seniors to ensure they are on track to pathway completion and graduation and review post-high school plans.	-Mrs. Brumby, 12th grade counselor -Mrs. Scott, 11th grade counselor
