Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are writing to you today because your child is currently enrolled in Algebra 1 or Algebra 1 Honors at Creekside High School and recently took the FSA Algebra 1 End of Course Assessment. Earning a level 3 or higher on this assessment is a graduation requirement, and this End of Course Exam will count as 30% of your child's grade in Algebra 1 or Algebra 1 Honors. We anticipate receiving the results of this assessment in mid-June, but want to make you aware now of a summer opportunity for students who do not earn a passing score.

The Summer Algebra Program at Creekside High School will be held June 28th through July 21st 8AM-12PM. While attending the program, students will receive instruction in key concepts from Algebra 1 in person from a certified math teacher. Bus transportation will be provided, and students who attend the program missing fewer than 2 days will earn a half credit elective on their high school transcript. Students will re-take the Algebra 1 EOC on July 20th and 21st.

In June, a school representative will contact the parents of each student who does not earn a 3 or higher to confirm their child's attendance at the Summer Algebra Program.

Although attending the Summer Program is not required to retake the EOC, it is highly recommended.
