Link Crew is a high school transition program that welcomes freshmen and makes them feel more comfortable throughout their first year of high school. Built on the belief that students can help other students succeed, Link Crew trains mentors from rising junior and senior classes to be Link Crew Leaders for the following school year. As positive role models, Link Crew Leaders are mentors and student leaders who guide freshmen to discover what it takes to be successful during the transition to high school. **Link Crew leader applicants should not have 5 or more unexcused absences or any referrals.**

- **Link Leader Training:** Wednesday, **July 27th**, 8:00am–12:00pm in the gym
- **Freshman Day:** Thursday, **July 28th**, 7:30 am – 1:00 pm in the gym
- **First day of school:** Wednesday, **August 10th**; wear Link Crew Leader shirt and help freshmen with directions, lockers, and questions.
