ii. Tests

- 1. Students must pass Grade 10 Florida Standards Assessment (FSA) in English Language Arts (ELA)
- Students must take the State End of Course Exam in
 - Algebra I pass exam to earn credit in course, 30% of final grade
 - Geometry 30% of final grade
 - Biology 30% of final grade
 - US History 30% of final grade

iii. Grade Point Average

An overall cumulative unweighted GPA of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale

iv. Take a virtual course before graduation.

Florida statute requires students in the Class of 2022 to take 1 virtual course before graduating from high school. Students that have not successfully completed the virtual course requirement may be enrolled in an online course their 12th grade year.
