Volunteering vs. Community Service

Volunteer / Community Service

- Bright Futures Scholarships require students to earn 75 100 documented volunteer and/or community service hours
- Forms can be found in student services (Building 100) and counselor offices.
- All students will turn "All" hours and forms into Ms. Becket in student services. The grade level school counselor will then collect the forms and put in myStudent.

Volunteer Hours

- Anything that is completed on the AHS campus, this includes concessions/ sporting events, assisting teachers, ABC closet, tutoring, etc.
- Students who volunteer at AHS will complete a volunteer profile (one time) and track hours on a blue volunteer log sheet.

Community Service Hours

- Community service is anything that takes place outside of AHS, examples are assisting at elementary schools, hospital volunteers, shelters, 5K's, etc.
- Hours will be tracked on a white volunteer log sheet.

Work Hours

• Students can submit paystub or W-2 for work hours to Ms. Barber to meet Bright Futures community service requirement. Need 100 hours and cannot combine with community service or volunteering hours.
