WHAT IS A CREDIT?

- You earn half a credit when passing a semester with at least a D.
- You earn a full credit when you pass the class for the year.
- If you fail a class, then you need to recover it .
- Remember that to graduate, you need specific credits!

WHAT IS COMMUNITY SERVICE?

AN ALTRUISTIC, UNCOMPENSATED VOLUNTEER EFFORT THAT BENEFITS THE COMMUNITY AND/OR SPECIAL POPULATIONS.

WHY COMMUNITY SERVICE???

*STUDENT COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE <u>BRIGHT FUTURES</u> SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IN FLORIDA.

* 100 HOURS FOR 100% TUITION/75 HOURS FOR 75% TUITION

* COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS ARE IMPORTANT FOR OUT OF STATE STUDENTS AS WELL TO INDICATE A WELL-ROUNDED STUDENT AND TO REMAIN COMPETITIVE IN APPLICATION PROCESS.

*COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS ARE NOT REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION.

HOW DO I REPORT COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS?

- STUDENTS DETERMINE WHERE THEY WANT TO COMPLETE THEIR COMMUNITY SERVICE AND COMPLETE A COMMUNITY SERVICE PROPOSAL FORM.

- ONCE COMPLETED, STUDENTS WILL TURN IN COMPLETED FORMS TO STUDENT SERVICES OFFICE OR MRS. HENSLEY FOR REVIEW AND TO DETERMINE IF IT IS ACCEPTABLE. STUDENTS WILL BE EMAILED (STUDENT EMAIL) WHEN PROPOSALS ARE REVIEWED AND READY FOR PICK UP (OR CAN BE EMAILED)
- IF APPROVED, STUDENTS WILL ACCESS COMMUNITY SERVICE LOG/REFLECTION FORMS TO TRACK THEIR HOURS OF SERVICE ON WRHS WEBSITE. THE FORM IS TURNED IN TO STUDENT SERVICES OFFICE UPON COMPLETION.
- STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE AND HAVE AN APPROVED PROPOSAL (UNLESS ON THE PRE-APPROVED LIST) FOR EACH AGENCY THEY WISH TO VOLUNTEER AND MAINTAIN SEPARATE LOG FORMS. FOR HOURS EARNED.

IF YOU CHOOSE TO SUBMIT FORMS ELECTRONICALLY (LINK AVAILABLE ON WEBSITE)— YOU HAVE TO SUBMIT EACH DAY OF SERVICE.

ALL FORMS MUST BE FILLED OUT LEGIBLY, COMPLETELY, AND BE SIGNED BY THE SUPERVISOR OF THE COMMUNITY SERVICE COMPLETED IN ORDER TO BE REVIEWED.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

*STUDENTS MUST PERFORM THE SERVICE DURING NON-SCHOOL HOURS.

* EACH COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT MUST HAVE A SOCIAL ISSUE THAT IS BEING ADDRESSED.

*ALL COMMUNITY SERVICE HOUR DOCUMENTATION MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE STUDENT'S GRADUATION DATE. ANY COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS SUBMITTED AFTER THE GRADUATION DATE EVEN IF EARNED PRIOR TO GRADUATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

*** UNLESS STATE GUIDANCE CHANGES DUE TO

HOURS NOT ACCEPTED FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE
 FAMILY RELATED ACTIVITIES OR SERVICE TO FAMILY MEMBERS, DEFINED AS:
 PARENTS, GRANDPARENTS, SIBLINGS, AUNTS, UNCLES, COUSINS, NIECES,
 NEPHEWS, AND SPOUSES, INCLUDING ALL STEP RELATIONS.

•HOURS THAT ARE COMPENSATED EITHER FINANCIALLY OR WITH SOME OTHER MATERIAL BENEFIT (INCLUDING GRADES).

•COURT MANDATED COMMUNITY SERVICE.

•SERVICE FOR THE SOLE BENEFIT OF A RELIGIOUS HOUSE OF WORSHIP AND/OR ITS CONGREGATION. ACTIVITIES SPONSORED BY THESE ORGANIZATIONS THAT BENEFIT THE COMMUNITY (MISSION TRIPS, COMMUNITY CLEANUP EVENTS, VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL) ARE ACCEPTABLE FOR BRIGHT FUTURES.

HOURS NOT ACCEPTED FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE

•CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES THAT ARE COURSE REQUIREMENTS.

•AN ACTIVITY WHERE THERE IS NO LEADER OR RESPONSIBLE ADULT ON SITE TO EVALUATE AND CONFIRM STUDENT PERFORMANCE.

•DONATIONS (EX. BLOOD, LOCKS OF LOVE, MONETARY CONTRIBUTIONS)

•HOURS SUBMITTED AFTER GRADUATION

HOURS ACCEPTED FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE

- FEEDING THE HOMELESS/FOOD PANTRIES
- VOLUNTEERING FOR ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY, FOSTER HOME, HOSPITAL, ANIMAL SHELTERS, HABITAT FOR HUMANITY ETC.
