- Two Connections classes (electives)

#### High School Courses for High School Credit in 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

- World Language Course Begins in 7<sup>th</sup> Grade (Spanish I) Criteria: Advanced Language arts
- 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Honors Literature, Honors Physical Science, and Honors GSE Algebra I courses begin in 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Honors Algebra criteria: Accelerated math in 6<sup>th</sup> grade and 7<sup>th</sup> grade
- Honors Physical Science criteria: Must be in Honors Algebra 1

## **SB289 Online Courses**

Students who are interested in taking an online middle school course must have the parent apply online during April/May/June on the district website for the following school year.

Online course opportunities are sometimes limited at both the middle and high school levels. Counselors advise both students and parents regarding online course opportunities. Please refer to the *MS 101* guide and/or the district *Career Planner* for further information.
