

Climate Star Rating Summary Brief 2017

The School Climate Star Rating is a diagnostic tool to determine if a school is on the right path to school improvement. The School Climate Star Rating is calculated using data from the Georgia Student Health Survey 2.0, Georgia School Personnel Survey, Georgia Parent Survey, student discipline data and attendance records for students, teachers, staff and administrators.

Each school will receive a 1-5 star rating, with five stars representing an excellent school climate, and one star representing a school climate most in need of improvement. Schools will have access to a comprehensive report which will allow them to identify areas in need of improvement, and plan targeted student interventions to improve achievement for all students.

School Climate Star Ratings were first calculated in 2014. The percentage of schools earning five stars has increased from 0% to 33.3% over the past four years.
