The SAT and ACT are entrance exams used by most colleges and universities as a part of a student's complete admission application to make admissions decisions. Exams are also used as part of the admission process for dual enrollment of 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade students. The PSAT is the Preliminary SAT assessment that provides students with indicators of strengths and areas of improvement in regards to how they would perform if they took the actual SAT assessment.
