EMERGING DISEASE

- Epidemic
 - Unusually high occurrence of a disease in a certain place during a certain time period
- Pandemic
 - When an epidemic affects many areas of the world
- Emerging disease
 - Infectious disease that has become increasingly more common in humans within the last 20 years or threatens to become more common in the near future
- Mhàss
 - Contact with infected animals
 - Pathogens become resistant to existing drugs
 - People lack appropriate immunizations
 - Increased frequency of international travel
