#### What is Peanut Allergy

**Aware?** Several of our students have a severe allergy to peanuts/tree nuts. This allergy can be life-threatening and, for these students, strict avoidance is the only way to prevent allergic reaction. Accidental contact or ingestion can be fatal.

Are peanut/tree nut products allowed in school? Yes. However, to reduce risk of exposure for students who are allergic to peanut products, these items are not sold in school lunch programs, at extracurricular events, nor provided in school-wide activities.

Many students have been seen recently in our clinic complaining of stomachaches after starting their day without breakfast. The excuse given: "they woke up late and did not have time."

Even a small breakfast item will help your child feel better for a good start to the school day.

#### SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM

The Summer Marine Science Program has extended the application process, as we still have some open sessions available! Calling all current fifth through seventh graders who love to be outdoors!

Applications can still be downloaded at any time from the website prior to April 19<sup>th</sup> at <a href="http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/marinescience/">http://www-grms.stjohns.k12.fl.us/marinescience/</a>. The link also will have a complete day by day curriculum for each grade level, parent information, and a video from last year's program.

Return the completed pre application to your child's science teacher who will turn it into the program. Once accepted, a final application will be mailed home within two weeks. Upon payment deposit and final application returned a confirmation of session letter will be mailed.

We currently ONLY have spots available in our third session, June 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, July 1, 2, 3. This is a perfect session to finish just before the Independence Day holiday. Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments. Learning is "hands on" in the field with students kayaking, canoeing, boating, hiking, snorkeling, sailing, windsurfing, surfing, SUP, (stand up paddleboarding), etc.

# **CHECKING OUT EARLY?**

All early check-outs, for any reason, are to be completed **before 2:15** (1:15 on Wednesdays). We ask that anyone sent to sign a child out be made aware of this policy. While it might seem best to have your child remain in class as long as possible, teachers are teaching specific intervention lessons during the last 30 minutes each day. Stopping to dismiss a child during that time interrupts the lesson for: a) your child, b) the group, and c) the two students who must also leave the room to accompany your child to the office ("never alone" policy requires two classmates escort a child to the front office).

**Your respect** for our dismissal policy helps maintain safety and security as we complete attendance/dismissal change/check-out reports *accurately* before students prepare for and move to their dismissal stations. It is often very difficult to locate students or get them ready to leave early during the last minutes prior to dismissal bell. Teachers and students are finishing lessons/reviewing homework assignments, packing up, or are en route to dismissal stations.
