







Cypress Creek Middle School Band

- There are 3 different performing level ensembles at CCMS.
 - Beginning Band *<u>No prior music knowledge needed!</u>*
 - M/J Band 1 is for students with no prior knowledge of instrumental music. Ideally the beginning student starts in 6th grade. There are 3 sections of beginning band at CCMS.



 M/J Band 2 or 3 is for students who have been in band for at least one year. Ideally the intermediate student is placed in this ensemble by audition after one year of beginning band. There is one section of Concert Band.

Advanced Level: Symphonic Band

M/J Band 2 or 3 is for students who have been in band for at least one year. Ideally the advanced student has been in band at least 2 years and is placed in our top ensemble by audition. There is one section of Symphonic Band.







Band Instruments offered

Woodwinds

Flute, Clarinet, Oboe/Bassoon, and Saxophone

Brass

Trumpet, French horn, Trombone, Euphonium, and Tuba

Percussion

Drums, mallets, auxiliary



In beginning band, students will have a chance to learn about and test out these different options with the director before they are placed on an instrument. Choosing a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument ensures that your student will be exposed to many different styles of instrumental music during their time at Cypress Creek. These styles include:

- Traditional concert band pieces
- Classical (solo & ensemble repertoire)
- Modern (marching and pep band tunes)
- Movie Scores
- Jazz



Band Performances

Beginning Band - M/J Band 1

The class is fun and engaging. Our main focus is tone quality and rhythmic accuracy in the first year. This group performs at the winter and spring concerts. After school commitments for this group are minimal. There is no "marching band" for this group.

Concert Band – M/J Band 2 & 3

This group performs at the winter and spring concerts, home football games, and pep rallies. After school commitments for this group are minimal. There is no "marching band" for this group.

Symphonic Band – M/J Band 2 & 3

This group performs at the winter and spring concerts, home football games, pep rallies, and MPA. Students may also audition individually for All-county, All-state, and Solo and Ensemble. After school commitments for this group are minimal. There is no "marching band" for this group.

CCMS Band students are involved in many other activities on campus such as athletics, student leadership, and NJHS

<u>Instrument costs</u>: We have a large selection of brand-new school owned instruments that are 100% free to use throughout the school year. These instruments are provided on a first-come, first-serve basis. Some students do choose to rent their instrument from a local music store.

<u>High School Band</u>: Our band program at CCMS feeds into the the Cypress Creek Band of Coyotes at CCHS. The CCHS band program offers Band 3, 4, 5, and 6 and currently has three main performing ensembles: Marching Band, Concert Band, and Jazz Band.


Our Mission:






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


SPRING MUSICAL
