High School Course Credit

Our Spanish 1 course is a high school credit class.

Students who successfully complete 8th grade Spanish will receive High School credit for Spanish I.

Upon entering High School, students may take Spanish 2 or begin a different language.

Grading



There are 2 types of grades:

- Formative grades: quizzes, homework, classwork
- Summative grades: tests, exams, projects and performance-based assessments (PBAs).
- Formative grades count for 20% of a student's grade.
- Summative grades count for 80% of a student's grade.



Homework

The most important homework task is for students to practice their vocabulary for 10-15 minutes a night!



Performance-based Assessments (PBAs)

Two PBAs for each semester

- Writing PBA: Students will write a paragraph in Spanish based on a prompt they are given.
- Speaking PBA: Students will record 1 minute speaking in Spanish based on a prompt they are given.
