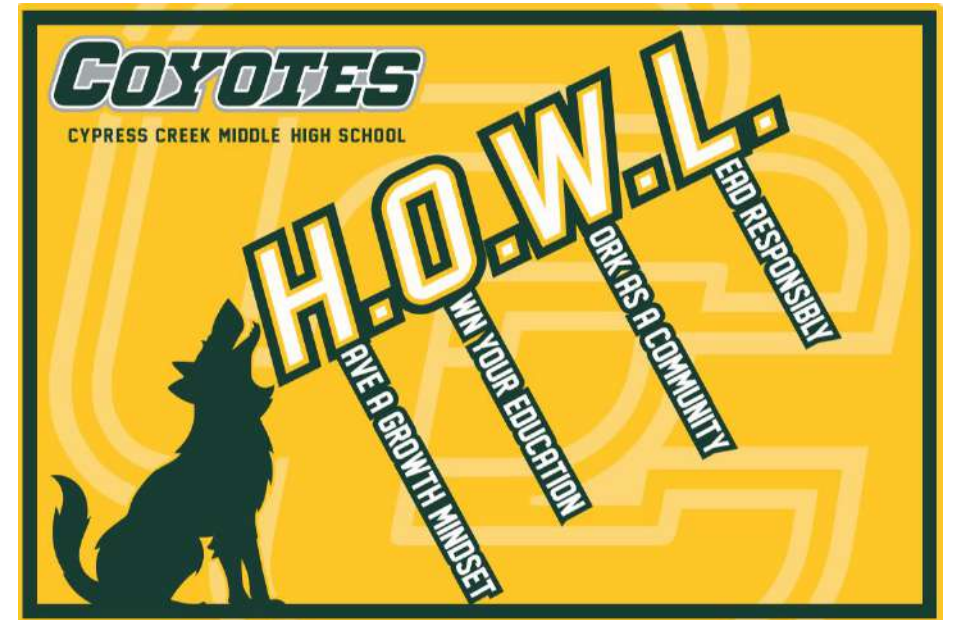

# AP EXPECTATIONS FORM

- Students will be required to complete the AP Expectations Form if choosing an AP class for next year
  - AP Expectations form will be online via the CCHS website under “Registration”
  - Forms will only be accepted electronically.
  - Deadline for completion is **MARCH 6<sup>th</sup>**.
- AP Expectations Form must be completed and read thoroughly; Parent must read thoroughly and sign form.
- Guidelines are strictly adhered to and enforced
- AP classes may have summer assignments. Make sure to check the CCHS website.



## DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Required 3.0 unweighted GPA and college readiness test scores on the ACT, SAT, or PERT
- Eligible test scores must be provided to Counselor by April
- If you are interested in DE for the Fall semester (12<sup>th</sup> grade), please see your School Counselor before Spring Break.

**Any current DE students who are limited to 12 credits (have not met the math score on the PERT) – must retake the PERT or take the SAT or ACT by April with eligible test scores.**
