Grading:

Testing:

All students are allowed opportunities to retest during the school year in order to show mastery of the standards taught. To retest, students are required to show evidence that they have tried to retest successfully by the measures decided on by the student and teacher. Retesting is offered before or after school. A retest may not be in the format that the original test was, but it will cover the same material.

Classwork/Homework:

> If the student does finish the assigned work, the work will be homework or completed the next day in class if instructed by the teacher.

- > If work is not handed in will result in a "M" or missing until the work can submitted. Otherwise the "M" will become a zero.
- If absent for any reason, the student is required to complete and return all missing assignments as arranged by Ms. Tanner.
- Notes quizzes and Tests are given through the year.

> CLASS NOTEBOOKS:

- The students binder are to be neat and organized.
- > The notebook will be divided into 4 sections for each of the 9 weeks in which there will be notes, organizers, activities, and other class assignments.
