The Classroom Experience:

Everything in the class will be shown in detail with steps and accessible 24/7 using OneNote. For instance, if a student asks a question, I'll help on a one-to-one basis while also showing the larger group the steps and answer on the board. As I'm showing the steps, I'll be using a platform that will display everything that is shown in real-time as I write on the board. It's not a video, but displays the writing using some pretty awesome software. Students and parents are able to see the steps/work from anywhere with an internet connection. The only obstacle is ensuring that I have your contact information. Please be sure to complete the form linked below in the communication section.

Grading Policy:

The final course grade that goes on your transcript at the end of the class will be based on 80% from quizzes and tests and 20% from your final exam.

Students can retake any assessment within 2 weeks of the initial administration. Students are also allowed 2 weeks from their return (after an excused absence only) to complete a missing assessment. There will be no partial credit awarded to students. Students must retake an assessment in its entirety after the teacher creates a similar but different assessment designated as the retake for the original.

Other Expectations:
