Dual Enrollment Admission

Requirements Changes Due to COVID-19

Due to the decision made by the College Board and ACT to temporarily suspend ACT/SAT and Accuplacer testing due to COVID-19, colleges/universities are authorized to evaluate their summer and fall 2020 Dual Enrollment (DE) applicants without SAT, ACT, or Accuplacer scores. However, the new DE rules/legislation require 10th grade students to meet testing requirements. 9th grade students are not eligible for DE. *10th Graders who have a minimum SAT score of 1200 or minimum ACT composite score of 26 in a single national test administration, may enroll in any approved courses listed on the course directory at a TCSG, USG or private eligible participating postsecondary institution.

*9th grade students are not eligible to participate in dual enrollment

<u>First Steps for students interested in dual enrollment for the Summer/Fall 2020 semesters:</u>

- ♦ E-mail your high school counselor to virtually discuss Dual Enrollment (DE) opportunities.
- Once you have made contact with your counselor to discuss your plans/academic standing for DE, please access the application admissions link above for the college/university of your choice. You will have to request for a transcript to be sent to the college/university from your high school and any additional information that may be requested by the college/university.
- Remember, the testing requirement suspension is <u>temporary</u> (only for Summer/Fall 2020). However, the new DE rules/legislation require 10th grade students to have the required test scores as listed above. Students should still plan to take the ACT/SAT and/or ACCUPLACER once those opportunities are available again.
