EMPA'	IY / UNDERSTANDING:
•	 Be specific about the problem but don't focus on the behavior, assume or blame. Stick to the facts or externalize the problem. Examples: "I've noticed that" "waking up has been tough lately" "something's been up with the homework" "something about group hasn't been working for you lately" "we've been arguing about food a lot lately" "its been tough to sit still during seated work"
•	OO YOU HAVE ANY IDEA WHAT THE CHILD'S CONCERNS MIGHT BE? O What types of clarifying questions might you ask? O What type of educated guesses might you make if needed?

3. Invitation to Brainstorm

- Frame the problem: "I wonder if there's a way that...." (repeat their concerns and your concerns)
- · Give kid first crack at it ("Do you have any ideas?) but provide help if needed

4. After the Invitation

- Any idea is a good idea! Litmus test: Does it work for you? Does it work for me?
 Doable? Bring up any other concerns?
- If neither of you has any ideas, come back to it later.
- If you do come up with a solution, see try it out and then come back and talk about how it worked!
