Crab Soccer Rules and Information:

Players: Goalies-can use hands and play on their knees; may not stand up

Kickers- on all fours in crab position; dribbles and kicks ball with feet

Any number can play

Court Half the basketball court with the goalie area designated at each end.

Playing Positions: alternate kicker and goalies after each goal is scored

Goalies on knees in front of the goal line and can use their hands to prevent the ball from crossing the goal line but **cannot** catch the ball. Kickers move in crab position and kick the ball to goal to score, they

cannot use their hands.

Fouls: types- rough kicking

Kickers using hands

Kickers out of crab position

Goalie catches a ball – free kick from two feet from goal line.

Penalty- award a free kick where foul occurred

Play: Play begins with a center kick from a dropped ball between two opposing

players.

Out-of-bounds: throw the ball in where it goes out.

Free Kick: when a foul is made.

Score: one point per goal

Note: if a goalies stand up opposing scores automatically.
