## Information Technology Security (ITSEC-AS) – Career Pathways Agreement between Pensacola State College

THIS CAREER PATHWAYS ARTICULATION AGREEMENT is entered into by and between THE DISTRICT BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF PENSACOLA STATE COLLEGE, FLORIDA, hereinafter referred to as the "College," and the George Stone Technical Center as part of the Escambia County School District, hereinafter referred to as the "District," in order to establish and validate an articulation agreement which supports the implementation of a Career Pathway.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Education has adopted educational opportunities under the Carl D. Perkins Career and Technical Education Act of 2006 (Sections 122 (c) (1)(A)and Section 135) to more fully develop the academic and career technical skills of students who elect to enroll in career and technical education (CTE) Programs of Study; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the Program of Studies requirements the parties hereto have recommended that students enrolled in core academic and CTE courses beginning at the secondary school level through a complementary postsecondary component shall have the opportunity to receive postsecondary credits applicable to their post-secondary program of study credential to ultimately include, but not limited to, a certificate, advanced technical diploma or associate of science degree provided, however, that students meet the minimum requirements and conditions herein set forth below; NOW THEREFORE,

**FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION** of these premises and other good and valuable consideration, the College and the District do hereby agree and covenant each with the other the Career Pathway as follows:

Successful completion with a grade of "B" or better in all of the following postsecondary level coursework or attainment of appropriate state-recognized industry certification.

- 1. The District's Program of Study/Career Academy and required core course/s:
  - a. Computer Systems & Information Technology (CSIT)
  - b. CTS0082 Computer Systems Technician (300 hours)
  - c. CTS 0083 Computer Network Technician (150 hours)
  - d. CTS 0084 Computer Networking Specialist (150 hours)
  - e. CTS0069 Computer Security Technician (300 hours)

College credit will be awarded upon request to the student for the following courses:

- 2. The College's Program of Study, required course(s), and number of college credits: **Cybersecurity (ITSEC-AS)** 
  - a. CET1020C Introduction to Networks (3 College Credits)
  - b. CET1610C Routing and Switching Essentials (3 College Credits)
  - c. CET1178C- PC Hardware A+ (3 College Credits)
  - d. CET1179C- PC Operating Systems A+ (3 College Credits)
- 3. Minimum requirements and conditions for students:
  - a. Complete the postsecondary school course(s) listed above with a final grade of B or higher.
  - b. Complete fifteen (15) college credits at the College in courses other than the course(s) stated in 2.a., 2.b., 2.c, and2.d. above within two (2) years from graduation from the District in order to receive the college credits in 2.a., 2.b, 2.c, and 2.d. above.
  - c. College credits for coursework defined in 2.a., 2.b., 2.c, and 2.d. above cannot be awarded if the requesting student attempts those course(s) at the College.
  - d. Waivers to this Agreement will be initiated through the College CTE/Career Pathways Office.
