Keone'ula Elementary School will be restarting Cub Clubs after being on hold for three years. Cub Clubs is an after school enrichment program. Session 1 runs from November 1 to December 9, 2022. Session 2 from January 23 to March 3, 2023. Students will have the opportunity to participate in **one session** of the many clubs run by staff members.

Attached is an application/consent form along with a short description of the various clubs available, targeted grade levels, and meeting days/times.

Applications will only be accepted in the **office** (not by classroom teachers), from **Monday**. **September 19 through Thursday**. **September 29**, **2022**. They will only be accepted by students before school-7:30 am-7:45 am, during recess, and after school until the office closes at 4:00 pm, or by adults throughout the work day from 7:30 am-4:00pm. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Space is limited to 20 students per club per session. Availability is on a first-come, first-served basis. Notification letters will be sent home by October 17, 2022 regarding the ability for participation. Students who do not make it into a club will be waitlisted and may have an opportunity to participate if availability arises throughout the year.

Attendance is crucial for the success of Cub Clubs. 3 unexcused absences from the club may result in removal, so please be sure to find a club that accommodates your child's and your schedule.

We look forward to helping your child expand his/her knowledge beyond what is taught during the school day. Join a club, learn new skills, and have fun!
