and scores in
50th PERCENTILE
on standardized tests

A student who reads

1:00

minute per day

will be exposed to
8,000
words per year
and scores in
10th PERCENTILE
on standardized tests

Grades in Enrichment

While Enrichment is a non-graded class, students record completed books on their reading log. Teachers do regular check-ins to help students meet their 25 book reading goal (for the year).

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How Can Parents support Enrichment Class?

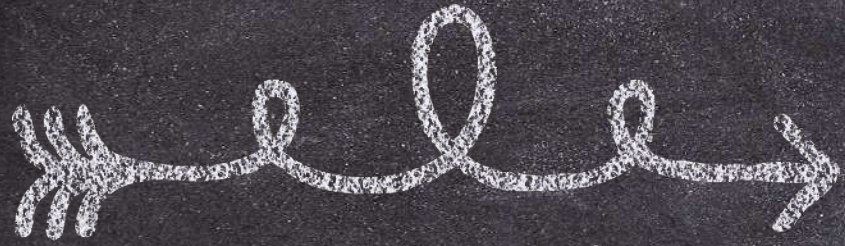
1. Ask your children to share their current reading choices.
