Registration Materials

- All CURRENT OHS students will receive all of their registration materials on
Tuesday 1/21/20
- The OHS counselors are in the process of visiting our main feeder schools: LCMS, JHMS, ITMS and St. Lukes to give them the registration materials.
- We mail registration materials to the other middle schools, so you can check with your student's middle school counselor.

Registration Process

Current Oviedo High School Students

- Your student's current OHS core teachers will enter the core classes for next year that they recommend for each student.
- Example if your student is a 9th grader in Algebra 1 Honors, your student's current Algebra 1 Honors teacher will enter the next recommended course for them to take. They may pick, for example, Geometry Honors. They will meet with the students during class to discuss their selection between 1/21 and 2/5. After that the teacher spreadsheet will be finalized on 2/6 and uploaded to skyward 2/7-10.

Registration Process

Current Oviedo High School Students

- If the students or parents would like a different class, for example, standard Geometry, the student will need to discuss this with their teacher. If their teacher is in agreement with this change, they will change their request for the student.
- If the teacher is not in agreement with the change, the parent can sign the waiver form on the course selection card and the counselor will change the request in skyward.

Registration Process

Current Oviedo High School Students

- THIS IS THE ONLY WAY IT WILL BE CHANGED IN SKYWARD. IF THE PARENT DOES NOT SIGN THE PARENT WAIVER SECTION OF THE COURSE CARD, THE STUDENT WILL BE PLACED IN THE CLASS THAT THEIR TEACHER RECOMMENDS FOR THEM. If a parent chooses to sign a parent waiver and override the teacher recommendation, the student will be required to stay in that class at least a semester.
- The students are entering ONLY their elective course requests for next year in Skyward.
- Students without computer access may turn in their course request cards and the counselors will enter the elective course requests.

Important Dates for CURRENT OHS Students

- Skyward will be open from 2/11-13/20 for students to enter in their elective choices.
- ALL course registration cards are due 2/14/20.
- Students will turn their cards in to their English teachers. Students without English classes on campus can turn their cards into the front office.

Dual Enrollment

- Academic Dual Enrollment- students must have a 3.0 unweighted GPA and a college ready score on the SAT, ACT, or PERT.
- BE CAREFUL WITH DUAL ENROLLMENT. You need to make sure your student is academically ready and mature enough to take a college class because they are starting their college transcript and if they do poorly that can affect 4 year University admissions, scholarships and financial aid.
- If you plan to take a dual enrollment core class, you will need to fill out the application, 868 form and registration form. Once that is complete, we will change your request on skyward. If you plan to take a dual enrollment elective class, you can sign up for the dual enrollment course code when you request your electives. If you do not turn in the dual enrollment information by the end of the school year, you will be taken out and placed in an elective here on campus.

Virtual School-Current OHS Students

- Open to all students
- SCVS and FLVS are available during or in addition to your school day year round.
- **If you register for a virtual elective on your schedule for next year, you MUST request the SCVS course by 2/14/20-the same day your registration cards are due. If you don't register for the actual virtual class, then you will be dropped from the virtual period. You can register 6 months in advance.**
- You also need to complete a virtual Class Request Form.

- If you are planning on taking a core class through SVCS next year, you will need to request the course online and fill out a virtual request form. Once the counselors receive the form and verify you have registered for the class, we will change your request in skyward. If you don't fill out the form AND sign up for the actual class, you will stay in the class here on campus.
- To register for an SCVS course, please go to www.scvs.us and click on the big green rectangle that says "Register for Courses Here" and follow the instructions.

Virtual School-Incoming 9th grade Students

- If you are currently taking a virtual class, you need to finish that class and make sure your middle school has the records. At that point, you can change your school path to Oviedo High School so that you can request the virtual classes you want and we can see them and approve them.
- **If you request a virtual class on your registration card for next year, you MUST request the SCVS course by the end of the school year. If you don't register for the actual virtual class, then you will be dropped from the virtual period and placed in a class on campus. You can register 6 months in advance.**
- You also need to complete a virtual Class Request Form.

Virtual School Tips

Expected Pace

Students are expected to follow the pace set by the teacher. Students can be withdrawn from a virtual course if they do not submit work according to the timeline set by the virtual teacher.

Monthly Calls

Students are required to make contact with each course instructor monthly. This is an excellent opportunity to touch base and review pace and progress in the course. This contact can be completed via call, text, or email. A parent or guardian must be present and/or reply to an email/text message in order to complete the monthly call.

DBA's (Oral Assessments)

DBA's (or Discussion Based Assessments) are oral assessments between the student and instructor. DBA's are required in each course and cannot be skipped or done more than one at a time. They must be completed according to the pace chart. In order to have a great DBA experience, it is important that students are in a room without distractions or other people. The instructor will ask questions pertaining to the previous module. This is an opportunity for students to demonstrate a mastery of the module topics.
