
DIGITAL DAYS

- Be prepared to show work in class and online for daily assessments



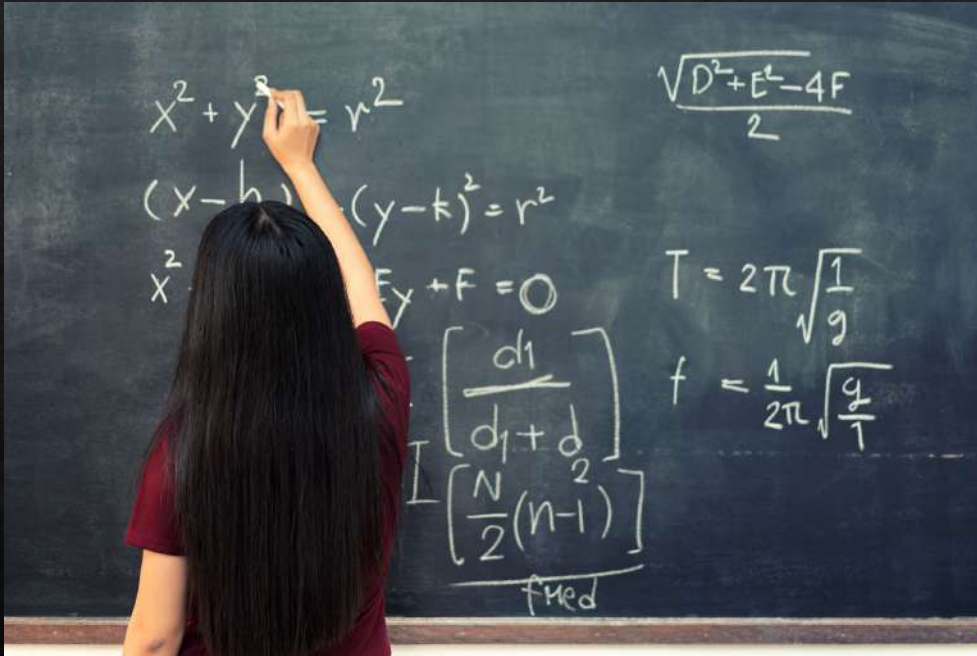
