- If you are absent, continue working on Canvas!!



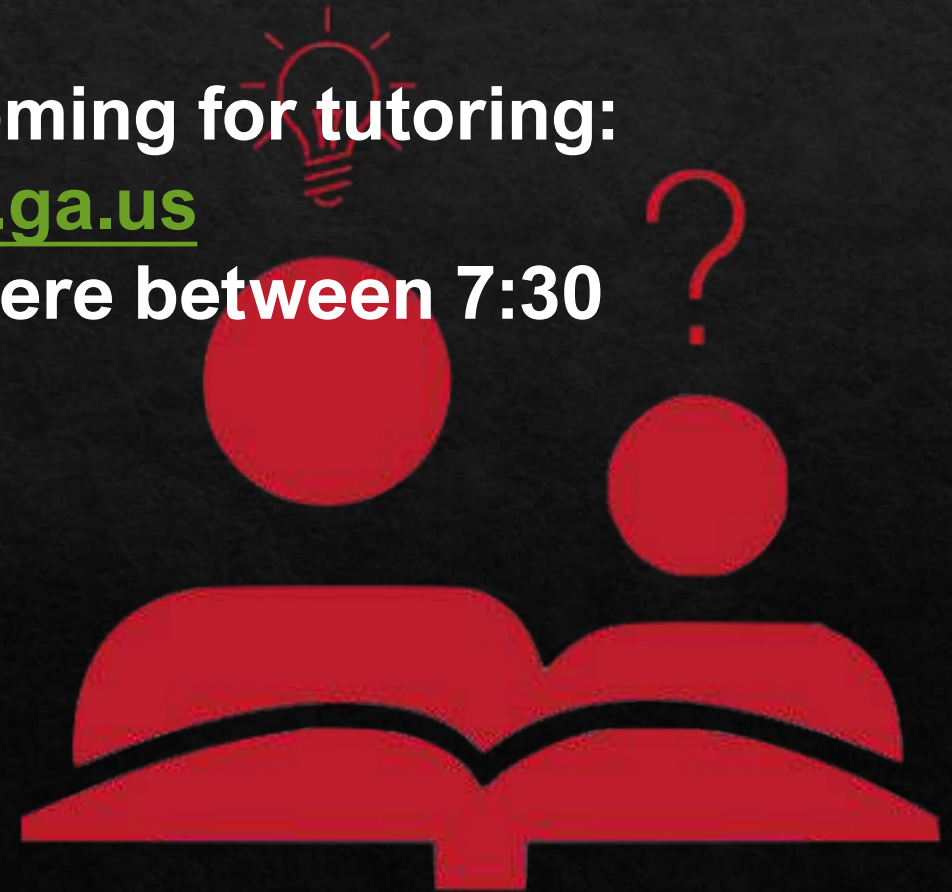
