8th Grade Dance Dress Code

- Boys may wear nice black jeans, dress slacks, or khakis with a nice shirt.

8th Grade Promotion Ceremony Dress Code

All students are required to wear black and white only!!!

Young men's acceptable attire:

White or black shirt

White or black dress pants or black khakis – **no jeans**

White or black suit

Ties – red, patterns, stripes, etc to match school colors (<u>however, ties are optional</u>)

Shirts are to be tucked in

Belts are suggested, but are optional

Dress shoes – black or white only

Young ladies' acceptable attire:

Dresses, pantsuits, or skirt/dress pants and blouse

If a top is worn that is out of dress code, you must wear and keep on a cover-up

Dress/skirt length can be no shorter than a dollar bill width above the knee

Dress straps must be at least 2 inches wide

No cleavage!

Accessories (jewelry, belts, shoes) may be in red to match school colors

Failure to adhere to these requirements will result in being disqualified from the ceremony.
