### **Athletics from Athletic Director Jen Darty**

Varsity Football won over Lyman on Friday, 43-13, to secure the District Championship! Jacob Thelen had 100 yards receiving and two touchdowns, Jackson LaTour had four touchdowns passing, Noel Keller had an interception, and DJ Scott had two touchdowns rushing.

Oviedo Lions swimming and diving competed in the FHSAA District 3 Swimming and Diving Championships. Multiple individual wins came from Seniors Kaylin Herbet in the 50 and 100 freestyle, and Luca Oliva in the 200 I.M. and 500 freestyle. Senior Marin Rose came away with a win in the 500 Freestyle and both boys and girls grabbed the top spot in the 200 and 400 freestyle relays. Divers Molly Connell, Tessa Sims, and Chloe Dunn took 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the diving championships while Carson Powers came in 2nd for the men, putting Oviedo on top once again, edging out Lake Brantley for the girls and boys District Champion titles.





Cross Country competed at the District Championships on Saturday at West Orange High School. The Girls Team was led by Maya Cabal who finished 23<sup>rd</sup> overall. Hannah Adamson and Alyssa Wahl each ran personal best times as the team ran fast enough to advance to the Regional Meet. The Boys took second place honors, led once again by Marc McDonald who placed 3<sup>rd</sup> overall. Robert Bellamy, Aiden Aysun and Yaniel Petrovich each contributed with personal records. Both teams will run at Regional Championships in Gainesville this Saturday.

Boys Golf played in the Panther Invitational on Saturday and finished 4<sup>th</sup> overall. Hayden Kinder and Tre Dahm were the top performers.

Girls Golf finished 8<sup>th</sup> at the District Tournament yesterday at Cypress Head. The team was led By Hannah Booth who shot a 79 over 18 holes.

Also competing in the District Tournament yesterday, Boys Golf finished 6<sup>th</sup> overall. Hayden Kinder led the team & qualified for the Regional Tournament next week.

Girls Bowling finished 6<sup>th</sup> at the District Tournament. Tayler Hennessy finished with a 455 three-game series, which earned her 5<sup>th</sup> place among all bowlers. Emily Harvey finished with a 384 three-game series taking 16<sup>th</sup> overall.

Boys Bowling competed in the District Tournament yesterday and came away at 4<sup>th</sup> place. Zack Horrobin bowled a 679 taking 1<sup>st</sup> place overall and qualifying for the State Tournament! Adrian Maduro was close behind with a 658 taking 3<sup>rd</sup> overall and also qualifying for the State Tournament!

Girls Varsity Volleyball won in the Region Quarterfinal last night over Lyman, 25-14, 25-14, 24-14. Offensively, the team was led by sophomore Anna Cathcart with 13 kills & junior Kylie O'Brien with 11. Junior setter Paige Wisneski dished out 20 assists along with sophomore setter Olivia Klimis adding 13. Defensively, senior Lily Cammack led with 12 digs and junior Jamie Kapoor had 6 blocks. With the win, the team will travel to Horizon High School on Saturday for the Region Semifinal match.

In Powder Puff action, the seniors came away with the win this year 35-7. The Juniors touchdown came from a long bomb pass from Riley Fennell and catch by Makenna Smith. The defense of the seniors logged 2 interceptions by Delaney Warner and Aya Wakim with 2 tackles for loss by Eliana Namansango. The high powered offense was fueled by touchdown runs by the quarterbacks Trinity Korn and Madi Terrell. Micayla Williams had two rushing touchdowns and Lindsay Wood caught a 60 yard touchdown catch. Jade Boozer and Rowen Waisanen followed up the extra point attempts.
