National Athletic Training Month is held every March to help spread awareness about the important work of athletic trainers. The 2023 slogan is "There's An AT For That". Athletic training is an allied health care profession that encompasses the prevention, examination, diagnosis, treatment



and rehabilitation of emergent, acute or chronic injuries and medical conditions. Athletic trainers provide medical care and supervision during games and practices and develop injury prevention programs to keep athletes healthy and on the field. AT's must graduate with a minimum of a bachelor's degree in athletic training from an accredited college or university, pass a comprehensive Board Certification exam, meet ongoing continuing education requirements, and maintain a medical healthcare license in the state of Florida. Should an injury occur, athletic trainers are able to diagnosis, treat and rehabilitate an injured athlete and return them to their sport as quickly and safely as possible.

Oviedo High School's Athletic Training Program works under the direction of Dr. Randy Schwartzberg of Orlando Orthopaedics, and in cooperation with other health care professionals, administrators, athletic director, coaches, and parents. We currently staff 4 certified athletic trainers, and 17 student athletic training aides that help care for our 48 interscholastic sports teams. While in the program, students learn basic athletic training techniques and provide invaluable assistance to the certified AT's in the coverage of athletic events.

Our annual Sports Physical Night will be held at Oviedo High School in the PE GYM on Monday, March 6 from 5:00-6:30pm. The cost of a Sports Physical is \$25, cash or check made out to Oviedo High School.

In conjunction with our Physical Night, we have also added the option to get an Electrocardiogram (ECG) on our campus with a nonprofit organization that Seminole County Public Schools has partnered with called Who We Play For. Starting in the 2022-2023 school year, Seminole County Public Schools requires an ECG for every athlete prior to playing a high school sport. Heart screenings will only be required one time in a child's high school career.

ECGs will be available for \$20 from 3:00-6:30pm through Who We Play For. To receive an ECG on Monday, March 6 at Oviedo High School, use the link to sign up for ECG registration.


